Dear SJHS parents and guardians:

We hope you and your families are having a wonderful summer! We are in the midst of preparing for the 2021-22 school year and wanted to share some beginning of the year information with you. With Spring Canyon Middle School opening this year, we are transitioning to a student body of only 8th and 9th graders from the entire Springville community. We look forward to enlarging the SJHS family this year, and hope all of our new and returning students will have wonderful experiences at Springville Junior High before heading to Springville High School together!

Online Registration and Student Schedules

The online registration portal in Infinite Campus opened in the spring. The online registration process consists of verifying your student's information, updating your contact information, and electronically signing any documents required by the district and state. If you have not already updated your information online, please visit the school website for instructions regarding online registration (sjhs.nebo.edu/registration). Please complete this process by **July 30, 2021**. Student schedules will be available in Infinite Campus starting **August 2, 2021**.

If you have moved, please upload your new proof of residency into Infinite Campus. New students will need to upload a birth certificate, proof of residency, and current immunization records. These documents must be uploaded in order to complete the online registration process.

Your student will be enrolled into classes after the school verifies that the online registration process has been completed and that all required documentation has been provided to the school. If you do not have computer access at home or need assistance, there will be SJHS staff available to help August 3 through August 13 from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm each day. You are also welcome to call our counseling office at 801-491-7548 if you have questions about registration. Our school counselors and counseling secretary will be available in the office on Wednesday mornings during the month of July.

Spanish-Speaking Liaison

Our Spanish-speaking liaison will be available to interpret for Spanish-speaking families who may need assistance with registration. Please call the school at 801-489-2880 to reach our liaison.

Open House

An open house will be held on August 16 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm. All students and parents are invited to come meet teachers and see the school. There will not be a set schedule for the open house—all of our teachers will be in their classrooms for visits. **We encourage any students new to Springville Junior High to come to the open house at 1:00 pm** so they can find their way around with fewer people in the building. We will have maps of the school available.

Lockers

Each Springville Junior High School student will be assigned a locker. Locker numbers and combinations will be available on student schedules in Infinite Campus.

School Community Council

We welcome parent involvement on our School Community Council! Parent members on the School Community Council will serve a two-year term; they must have a student enrolled at SJHS for at least one of the years of that two-year term. School Community Council elections will be held Monday, August 16 through Friday, August 20. Voting will take place in the main office of the school. If you are interested in participating, please email our School Community Council facilitator, Jentry Youd, and let him know of your interest by Wednesday, August 11 (jentry.youd@nebo.edu). You may also nominate other SJHS parents by emailing Mr. Youd.

School Fees and Fee Waivers

Fees can be paid online **starting the week of July 26, 2021** (<https://bit.ly/sjhs-fees>). All credit card transactions, whether in person or online, will incur a \$2 fee as directed by district finance policy. *Yearbooks are listed under "optional fees" and can also be purchased online.* School lunches will be free for all students again this year.

Administrators will be available to review fee waivers on **August 6, 9, and 10 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm**. It is necessary to apply for a fee waiver annually; last year's application will not be valid for this school year. Students may receive a fee waiver for one of the following reasons:

- Family receives TANF (currently qualified for financial assistance or food stamps)
- Student receives Supplemental Security Income (qualified child with disabilities)
- Student qualifies for McKinney-Vento
- Student is in Foster Care (under Utah or local governmental supervision) or State Custody
- Student is eligible based on family/household income verification

Please bring the required income verification as described in the fee waiver application (<https://bit.ly/2ZOQjKS>). Please note that yearbooks are not subject to fee waivers.

PE Clothes

Students are required to wear athletic shorts without pockets, a t-shirt, and athletic shoes for all physical education classes. PE clothes will be given to each student during the first week of the semester. The cost of a PE uniform is covered by the PE class fee.

Picture Day

This year's picture day is on Tuesday, August 24. Picture order forms will be sent home with students on the first day of school. Starting mid-August, parents can also prepay for school pictures online (www.bellphotostore.com) with the code **Springvillejr21**. Picture retakes will be on September 28.
